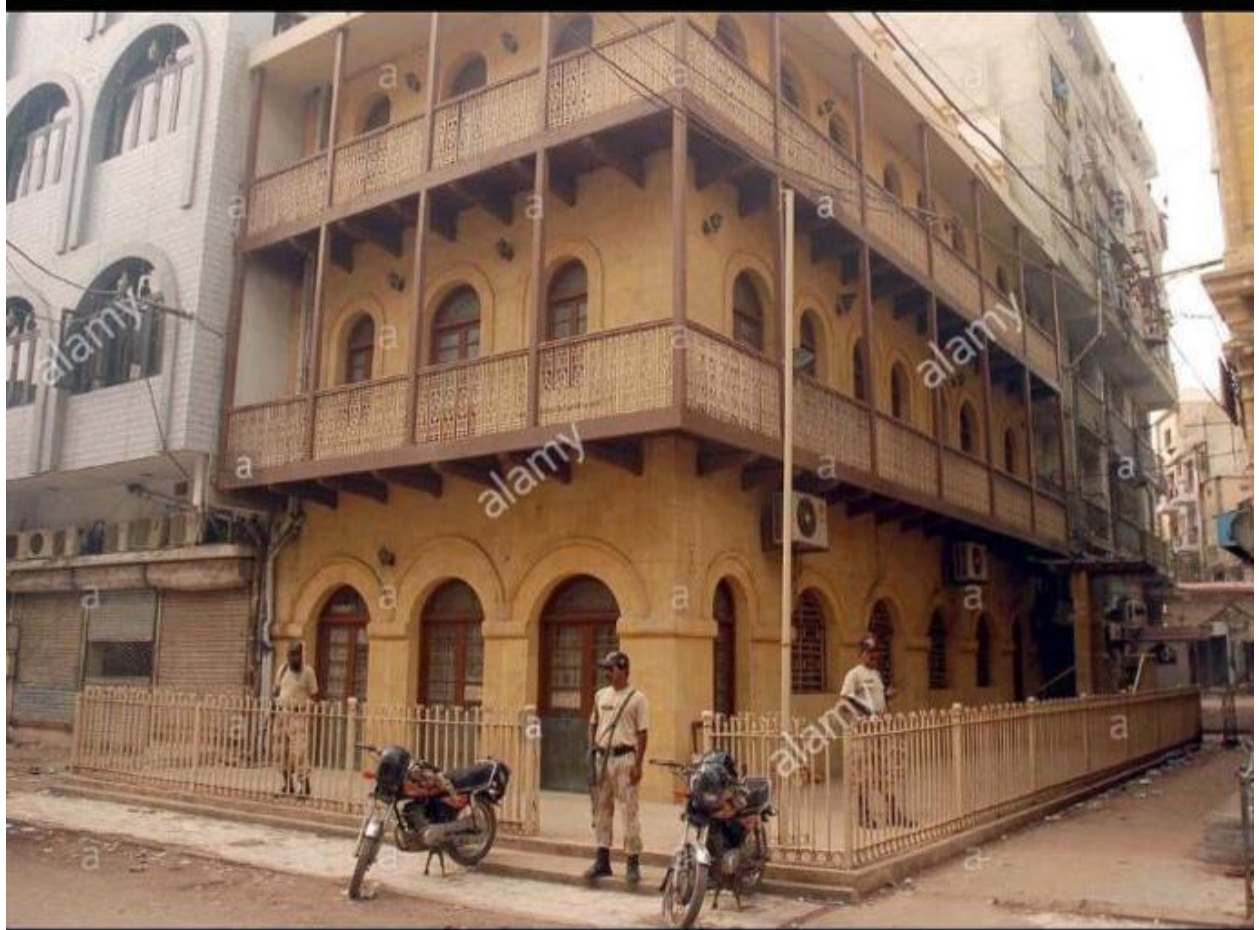


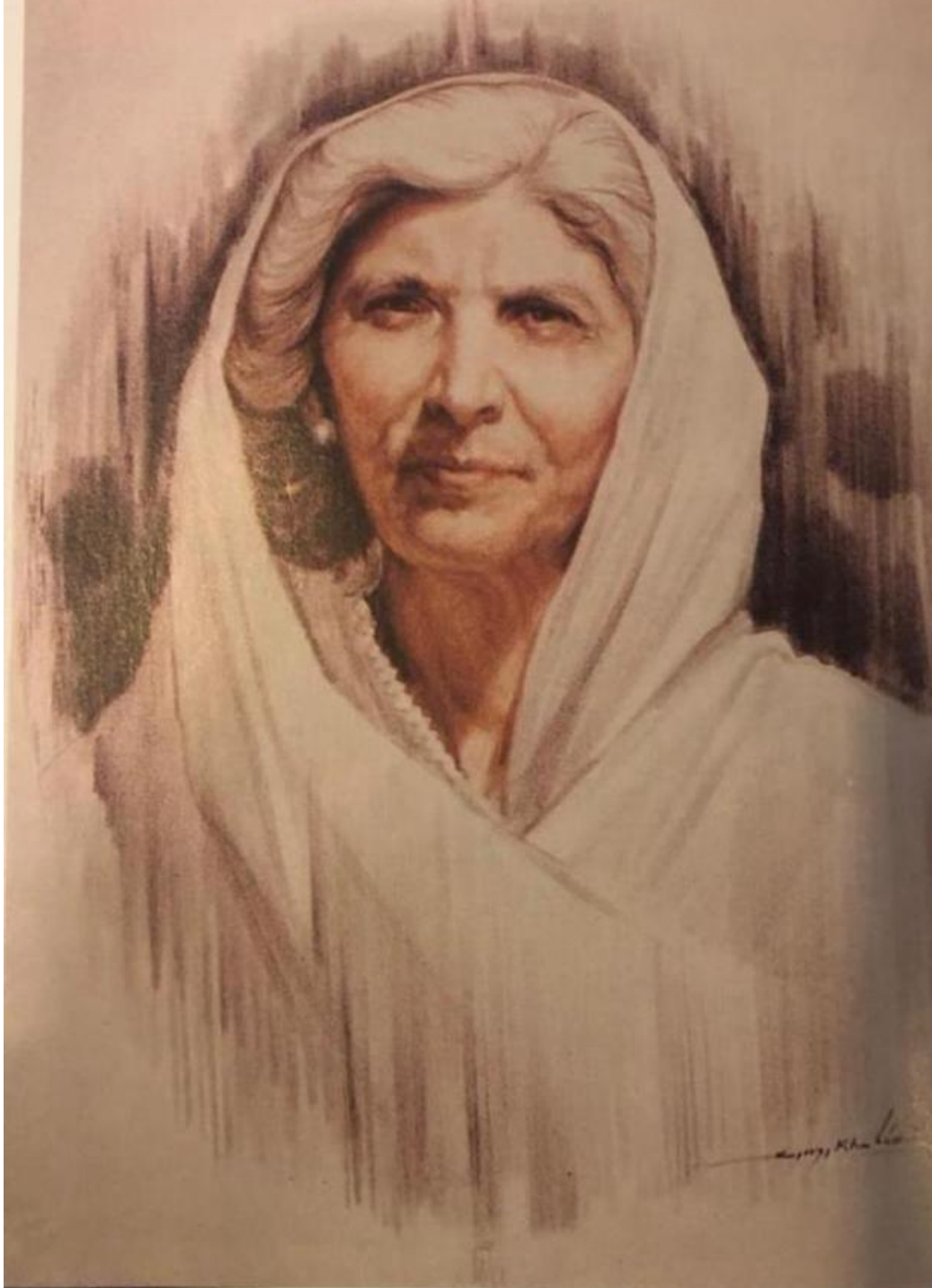

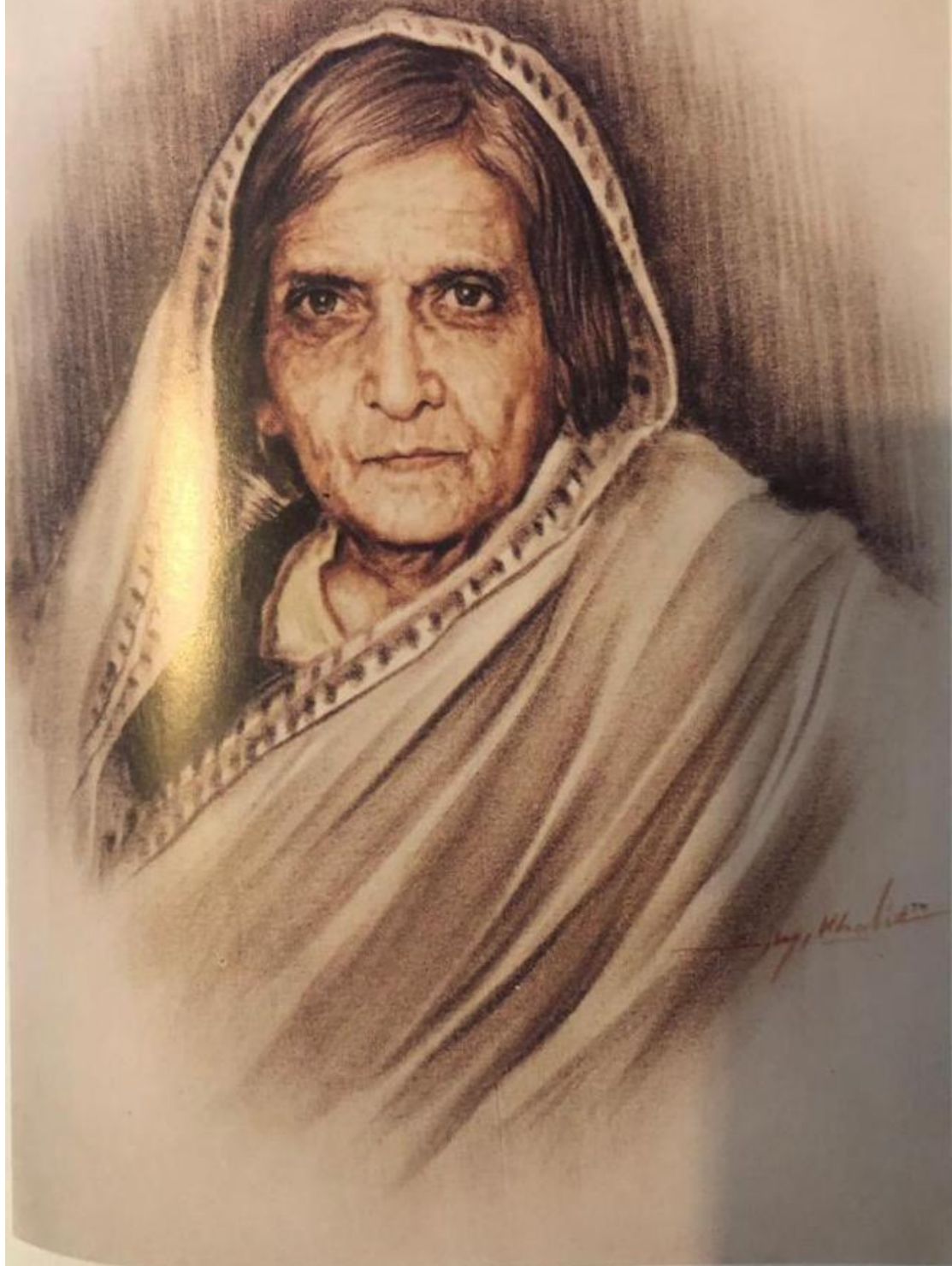
Wazir Mansion: Quaid's place of birth
